



Vendor Participation Information

The **Presbyterian Church of the Redeemer (PCR)** and the **Centerville Community Center** are sponsoring the fifth annual "Taste of Centerville - A Community Celebration" on Saturday, October 1st from 11 - 5pm. Years ago, The Church was the center of the community. Your local churches and community center are continuing this age old tradition of bringing the church and the community together for fellowship and fun.

The Taste of Centerville will feature local area restaurant tasting booths, neighborhood grill masters, international tasting tables, inflatable jumping area for children, face painting, arts and crafts booths, a live entertainment stage featuring a diversity of local performers, extreme quad bungee jump, extreme obstacle course, and a 33 foot high Titanic slide.

Application Deadline:

- All applicants must submit a complete application by September 2nd.
- Vendors will be selected on a first come first served basis.

Booth Fee/Information:

- Non food vendor booth cost - \$50.00. 10 x 10 space allocated.
- All food vendor applicants must be either an operating and licensed restaurant or offer a unique food item for vending.
- A business license is required for all businesses participating at the Taste of Centerville.
- Prior to the event, vendors must show proof of general liability insurance and name PCR as an additional insured.
- Must commit to being present for entire event.
- Must serve free samples of all food on menu.

Restrictions:

- No alcoholic beverages or loud music are allowed within or in the vicinity of your booth.

Signage:

- Vendors are allowed and encouraged to advertise outside their booth space. Sample menus, coupons, flyers and other promotional items are also encouraged.
- The Taste of Centerville reserves the right to restrict any activities that interfere with public access and/or festival programming. Non-compliance of this agreement will jeopardize your event participation.

Menu:

- Only menu items listed on the application may be at the Taste of Centerville. Please notify if any changes.
